



SCHOOL BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

Prosser Consolidated School District #116

At the school board meeting of May 19, 2009 the following occurred:

ACTION ITEMS:

- **2009 Prosser High School Summer Programs/Risk Management** The Board reviewed plans for Prosser High School FFA members in grades 9-12 to participate in camps, contests and fairs during the summer. Events will take place in Grandview, Goldendale and Kennewick. Students will have 24 hour supervision by the vocational director, staff and advisors. In addition, week long youth camps will be held at Prosser school facilities supervised by school coaches. And students in grades 9-12 will participate in a week long off campus camps in a variety of sports activities at various universities and colleges supervised by host staff and PHS coaches and personnel. The program was approved.
- **2009 Summer School Programs/Risk Management** The Board reviewed and approved summer school classes to be held at Keene-Riverview Elementary, Housel Middle School, Prosser and Prosser Falls High Schools.
- **Resolution 04-09: 2009-2010 WIAA Membership** The Board reviewed renewal of WIAA membership. Member high schools are billed based on average enrollment and the number of sports/activities in which they are enrolled. Renewal of WIAA membership was renewed by unanimous voice vote of the Board.
- **Vouchers** General Fund vouchers totaling \$181,022.01; General Fund Payroll Warrants totaling \$1,916,491.38 and Associated Student Body vouchers totaling \$13,220.31 were approved.
- **Consent Agenda** Minutes of the prior meeting were approved. Personnel actions were approved as follows.
Certificated Personnel: Pat Zuniga, Rich Harris and Kevin Cole resigned their positions as Assistant Football Coaches at Prosser High School. Seth Flajole, Sandra Haddow, Megan Oten, Julee Perry and Gale Wright were approved as Migrant Summer School teachers. Sue Severson Bray was approved as a .5 Migrant Summer School music teacher. Justin Kelly was approved as a school Psychologist for the 2009/2010 school year. Karyn Jamison resigned her position as a Kindergarten teacher at Keene-Riverview.
Classified Personnel: Rich Zoller resigned his position as Head Girls Soccer Coach at Prosser High School. William Patterson resigned his position as a bus driver effective May 5, 2009. Wendy Meirndorf was hired as Head Volleyball Coach at Prosser High School.

INFORMATION ITEMS:

- Prosser High School Principal Kevin Lusk reported the Class of 2009 will hold graduation ceremonies Sunday, May 31 at 2:00 p.m. at Art Fiker Stadium. Syndi Duehn, Dean of Students at Prosser Falls High School, reported that graduation ceremonies for the Class of 2009 will be held Friday, May 29 at 7:00 p.m. at the Princess Theatre.

AWARDS:

- Certificates of Achievement were presented to Prosser High School Students of the Departments for their outstanding academic performance in the current year.
- Certificates of Excellence were presented to the Top 10 Students in the graduating Class of 2009 at Prosser High School.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- **City of Prosser Water Charges** Dr. Ray Tolcacher presented Board members with a letter from City of Prosser Administrator Charlie Bush regarding past overcharges for water usage at Housel Middle School. He reported on the ongoing discussion to mitigate the issue and said another meeting with the city is being scheduled. Board Vice-President Kay Brader noted that no city council members or the mayor were present at their last meeting on the issue.

REPORTS:

Curriculum Director’s Report: There was no report as Mary Snitily was out of town on school district business.

Business Manager’s Report: Craig Reynolds reviewed the May 2009 enrollment which showed 42 students above the anticipated level. He also reported the district’s state audit was completed today and no major issues were noted.

Superintendent’s Report: Dr. Tolcacher had no report.

Board Member Reports: Warren Barmore reported attending the Missoula Children’s Theatre performance on May 15. Win Taylor reported on attending the Prosser High School Athletic Banquet May 18 at which Matt Ellis was the guest speaker. He also attended the Student Academic Success meeting held locally. Kay Brader thanked the Prosser School District staff and board for making the recent WSSDA Regional meeting in Prosser a success.
