You have a son or daughter who participates in our district's Bilingual Program.

The "No Child Left Behind" (NCLB) Act requires parents of English language learners (ELLs) participating in Washington's Transitional Bilingual Instructional Programs (TBIP) and/or Title III programs to be notified each year of Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAO) for the school district. The state of Washington did not notify the district of our AMAO results for years 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, and the 2006-07 until February 26, 2008.

Below is a description of each AMAO target:

AMAO-1: Annual increases in the number or percentage of children making progress in learning English.

AMAO-2: Annual increases in the number or percentage of children attaining English proficiency.

AMAO-3: The number or percentage of ELL students meeting AYP targets in reading and math on the WASL.
